Details to Highlight

On March 27th, Governor Sisolak issued a directive regarding essential businesses, that follows DHS/CISA guidelines.

On March 29th, Governor Sisolak signed an executive order that prohibits rental tenants, including small businesses, from being evicted for non-payment of rent. It also waives all fees associated with late rent payments.

On March 31st, Governor Sisolak signed an executive order that extends license expiration date by either 90 days after their current expiration dates or 90 days from the date Nevada's state of emergency is ended, whichever is later.
