- Title: max. 150 characters, total word count: 300
- Presenting author: last name and initials
- Institutions: max. 2 institutions for each author
- Introduction or background
- Aim of the study
- Methods
- Results
- Discussion and conclusions
- Practical and/or academic/research implications
- A maximum of 3 Keywords

All abstracts submitted will be peer-reviewed and feedback will be provided.
