Hats for the Homeless

Hats for the Homeless is a service project sponsored by the *Omicron Delta Chapter of Sigma, Honor Society of Nursing*.

Crocheted Hat

Materials

I (5.5mm) Hook Worsted weight yarn Tapestry Needle embellishments, etc.

Notes

These guidelines are for hats for elementary students and adults. <u>Instructions are for children's size.</u> If you would like to use other yarn, just make sure it is worsted weight, machine washable and dryable. Feel free to add colors, embellishments, etc.



Easy Double Crochet Cap

Round 1: Ch 3, work 11 more dc in ring. Join with a sl st to top of ch 3. (12dc) The beginning chain counts as your first st in each row. Do NOT turn at the end of the row.

Round 2: Ch 3, dc in same st, 2 dc in each dc around. Join. (24dc)

Round 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in next st, (dc in next st, 2 dc in next) around. Join. (36dc)

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in next st, 2 dc in next, (dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next) around. Join. (48dc)

Round 5: Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next; (dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next) around. Join. (60dc)

Rounds 6 - 11: Ch 3, dc in each st around. Join. If you want your cap a bit longer add an extra row of dc here.

Round 12: Ch 3, dc in next st, fpdc in next st; (dc in next 2 sts, fpdc in next) around, Join.

Round 13: Ch 1, sc in next st, fphdc over next fpdc; (sc in next 2 st, fphdc in next fpdc) around. Join. Fasten off. Weave in ends. You can add a pom pom at the top if you like!





Oh So Seedy Beanie

Gauge: Gauge is critical to sizing so please do a quick swatch to make sure your hat fits! 8 stitches in pattern and 10 rows is a 2 inch square.

Swatch: Ch 9. Row 1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook, (1 sl st in next ch, 1 hdc in next ch) 3 times, 1 sl st in last ch. (8) Rows 2-10: Ch 1, turn, (1 hdc in next sl st, 1 sl st in next hdc) across. (8) Resulting piece should measure 2 inches by 2 inches.

Size Circumference Height Approximate Yarn Amount

Toddler/Kids 18 inches 7 inches 2.5 ounces

Make Hat:

Round 1: Ch 2, (1 hdc, sl st) in 2nd ch from hook 6 times, sl st to first hdc of round to join. (12)

Round 2: Ch 1, turn, (1 hdc in next sl st, 1 sl st in next hdc) 6 times, sl st to first hdc of round to join. (12)

Round 3: Ch 1, turn, [1 hdc in next sl st, (1 sl st, 1 hdc, 1 sl st) in next hdc] 6 times, sl st to first hdc of round to join. (24)

Round 4: Ch 1, turn, (1 hdc in next sl st, 1 sl st in next hdc) 12 times, sl st to first hdc of round to join. (24)

Round 5: Ch 1, turn, [1 hdc in next sl st, 1 sl st in next hdc, 1 hdc in next sl st, (1 sl st, 1 hdc, 1 sl st) in next hdc] 6 times, sl st to first hdc of round to join. (36)

Round 6: Ch 1, turn, (1 hdc in next sl st, 1 sl st in next hdc) 18 times, sl st to first hdc of round to join. (36)

Round 7: Ch 1, turn, [(1 hdc in next sl st, 1 sl st in next hdc) twice, 1 hdc in next sl st, (1 sl st, 1 hdc, 1 sl st) in next hdc] 6 times, sl st to first hdc of round to join. (48)

Round 8: Ch 1, turn, (1 hdc in next sl st, 1 sl st in next hdc) 24 times, sl st to first hdc of round to join. (48)

Round 9: Ch 1, turn, [(1 hdc in next sl st, 1 sl st in next hdc) three times, 1 hdc in next sl st, (1 sl st, 1 hdc, 1 sl st) in next hdc] 6 times, sl st to first hdc of round to join. (60)

Round 10: Ch 1, turn, (1 hdc in next sl st, 1 sl st in next hdc) 30 times, sl st to first hdc of round to join. (60) Remaining Rounds: Repeat Round 10 until hat measures 6 inches. (60)

Make Ribbing: Work ribbing tightly. You may even want to go down a hook size.

Row 1: Ch 4, 1 sc in second ch from hook and across, 1 sl st in next 2 st on edge of hat. (3)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sk the 2 sl st you just made, 1 sc in blo of each st across. (3)

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in blo of each sl st across, sl st in next 2 st on edge of hat. (3)

Repeat last 2 rows around edge of hat.

Without fastening and with wrong side facing, sc the ends of the ribbing together. Fasten off.

Finishing: Weave in all your ends and enjoy! You can add a pom pom at the top if you like!

Abbreviations Hdc – half double crochet

Blo – back loop only Fpdc - front post double St- stitch

Ch - chain crochet SI st - slip stitch
Dc - double Fphdc - front post half- Sc - single crochet
