CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Deadline for Abstract Submissions - March 31st, 2021

You are invited to submit an abstract for a concurrent oral session. Appropriate projects should pertain to evidence-based practice, quality improvement, or nursing research in academia or clinical healthcare settings. Both nurses and nursing students are encouraged to submit work.

- Previously presented and/or previously published projects may be submitted.
- Research studies, evidence-based practice projects, and quality improvement projects will be considered.
- Only completed projects will be considered for the oral presentations.
- Oral podium presentations are limited to 20 minutes and *will be recorded for inclusion in the program*.
- More than one abstract per agency or author may be submitted.
- All abstracts will be reviewed and selected by a blinded peer-review committee.
- All presenters must register for the conference. Presenters are expected to assume costs related to travel, accommodations, and registration.

The <u>first page</u> of the abstract should include the following information:

- itle of the project
- Presenter(s) and Co-presenter(s) Name(s), Title(s), and Credential(s)
- Institutional Affiliation(s)
- Preferred mailing address (Primary Presenter)
- Daytime Phone Number (Primary Presenter)
- E-Mail Address (Primary Presenter)
- For presenters, provide a 150-word introduction for the presenter(s)

The <u>second page</u> of the abstract should not contain any identifying information for the authors or institution. Select the type of presentation (podium, poster, or both), add the abstract title and begin the abstract text. Abstract text is **limited to 300 words or less** using Microsoft Word. Font size should be 12 point with 1" margins on all four sides of the paper. All components of the abstract template below must be included in the abstract for consideration.
