Karen H. Morin, DSN, RN

Dr. Morin was recently elected to the position of President-elect at the Sigma Theta Tau International (STTI) Biennial Convention in Baltimore, MD. She has been on the STTI Board of Directors since being elected to a 4 year term in 2003 and has served in numerous chapter, regional, and international level positions.

Karen Morin has served as a member and faculty of the STTI and Johnson & Johnson Maternal-Child Health Leadership Academy Planning Committee, and the co-chair of the STTI/WHO Global Nursing Education Standards Initiative.
