

Common Questions and Answers regarding Delta Theta membership and Induction Ceremony

*****Please read this before contacting Delta Theta leaders. We receive the same basic questions repeatedly and so...here are the most common questions and responses to help you!**

1. How do I join Sigma Theta Tau-Delta Theta?

- A. In your last semester of your program (BSN, RN-BSN, Masters), all names of students who have met the following criteria: a) Nursing GPA above 3.0 (for Undergrad students) or 3.5 for Grad students AND b) be in top 35% of class. It must be both. All names are cleared through Office of Student Conduct. If a student has had a reported issue to this office, name is removed. See Sigma Theta Website for more info:

2. How do I join when I receive an invitation?

- A. Follow the information on the invitation. You must pay dues that include membership, honor cords and certificate. If you wish to be a part of the induction ceremony, you must pay that amount as well.

3. Who can attend induction?

- A. You are welcome to bring close family members. This is a University event and as such, it is preferred that young children have an adult to supervise. We ask that you RSVP so we have an estimated number.

4. What do I wear to induction?

- A. Nice business casual is recommended. You do not wear regalia. You will receive your honor cord that you can wear during graduation.

5. What if I can't attend Induction but can attend Graduation?

- A. Find Holly Woods while lining up for graduation. She will have additional cords and will give you cords once she checks that you paid dues and didn't receive them at the Induction.

6. What if I RSVPed but now can't attend Induction Ceremony?

- A. It is anticipated that at the last minute, some things can occur. If you can EMAIL the governance chair with this info, it is appreciated. See #5 if you still will be attending graduation.

7. If I don't attend Induction or Graduation how do I receive my materials?

- A. The week after graduation, we will send the certificate and the cords to the address you registered for this membership.
