Oklahoma Primary Care Association (OKPCA) is the statewide trade association for community health centers and receives funding from a cooperative agreement with the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) to provide training and technical assistance (T/TA).

OKPCA uses grant funding to deliver T/TA to:

- Increase access to comprehensive primary care
- Accelerate value-based care delivery
- Foster tomorrow's health care workforce
- Enhance emergency preparedness
- Advance clinical quality and performance

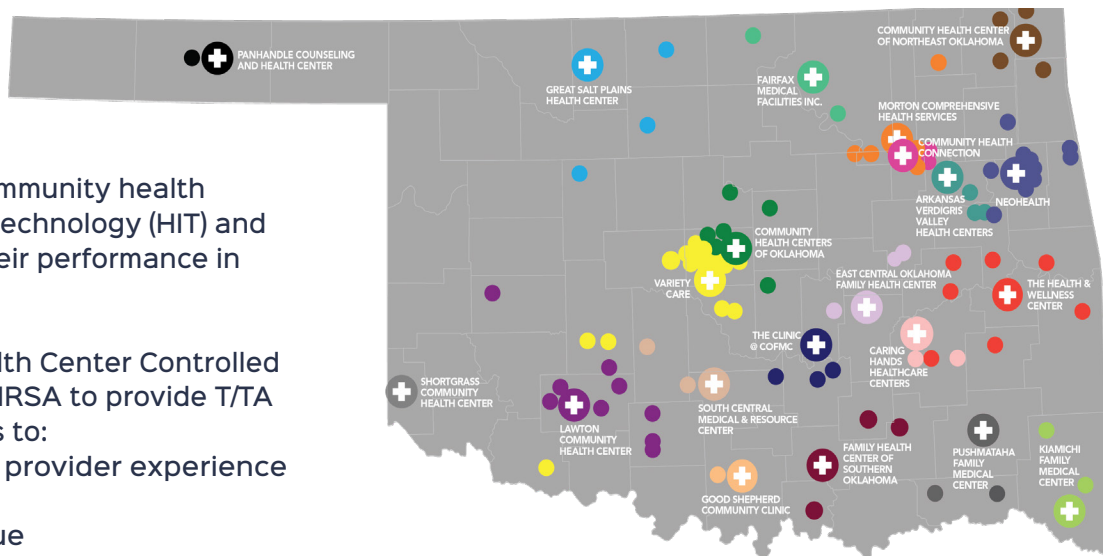

SoonerVerse leverages community health centers' health information technology (HIT) and data analytics to improve their performance in value-based care delivery.

SoonerVerse receives a Health Center Controlled Network (HCCN) grant from HRSA to provide T/TA to community health centers to:

- Enhance the patient and provider experience
- Advance interoperability
- Use data to enhance value
