



## 2022 PIMA Winter Insights Safety Measures

### Expectations & Precautions

Upon arrival, each attendee (staff, registrants, registered guests, and speakers), will be asked to sign a [Duty of Care Policy](#) that will signify agreement to and compliance of the meeting requirement that they have been fully vaccinated for COVID-19 or have had a negative COVID-19 test within the last 48 hours. The signature also attests that attendees are not currently experiencing any symptoms associated with COVID-19, have been diagnosed with or had exposure to COVID-19 in the past 10 days.

Badges will be required for all portions of the conference, including outdoor sessions. To pick up a badge, a signed *Duty of Care Policy* will be required. No badge will be issued to anyone who has not affirmed.

### On-site During the Event

PIMA is excited to be hosting an in-person conference. PIMA and the Naples Grande Beach Resort have put safety measures in place to provide a collaborative environment for attendees to receive educational programming and networking opportunities while also keeping your health and safety top of mind. The Duty of Care policy is an additional layer of protection rather than a substitute for existing measures, such as wearing masks, applying hand sanitizer and observing social distancing.
