Expectations & Precautions

PIMA is excited to be hosting a hybrid conference this summer. Our focus is to provide a collaborative environment for attendees to receive educational programming and networking opportunities while also keeping your health and safety top of mind.

For the on-site experience, PIMA will be practicing all necessary precautions and following the Hotel InterContinental New Orleans protocols that tie to the City of New Orleans protocols. You can find current city guidelines [here](#). Please see the hotel InterConNOLA Guidelines 2021 [here](#).

In addition, PIMA will:

- Provide masks, hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes;
- Have directional floor signage and dedicated points of entry & exit into the ballroom;
- Offer colored wristbands to signify to other attendees your preferences; and
- Offer reserved seating for those that prefer a dedicated seat each day.

All attendees agree to support our collective wellbeing by following PIMA's Attendee Code of Conduct and other health and safety directives issued by government agencies, PIMA or the facility from time to time:

Before Leaving Home

- Follow relevant guidance provided by the World Health Organization (WHO), CDC or your local health authority.
- Adhere to government-issued travel restrictions and guidance issued by the region you will be travelling to and the region you are travelling from.
- Evaluate your own health and that of people you are in close contact with. Contact the meeting/event organizers at conference@pimainsights.org if you have concerns.
- Stay home if you feel sick or are to be quarantining due to exposure.

On-site During the Event

Follow guidance from the local authority for everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses. Current requirements include:

- Wearing a mask at all times (except when actively eating or drinking).
- Adhering to social distance protocols put in place by the hotel and event organizers.
- Frequently washing hands or using an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched objects and surfaces using a cleaning spray or wipe.
- Removing yourself from the event and public space if at any time you feel unwell or are experiencing flu-like symptoms and continue participating using the virtual option.

Post-Event

Based on current contact tracing advice from many health authorities, if you test positive for COVID-19 after returning home up to the advised time from the CDC, please contact the meeting/event organizers at conference@pimainsights.org to advise them.
