A letter of nomination must be submitted on your behalf by a corporate member of PLAC or by a partner at your firm who is currently a member of this organization. Membership fees are \$1,750 per year for a maximum of five (5) years in the program or twelve (12) years of practice. After that time, your membership will automatically convert to a full Sustaining membership, and your dues rate will adjust accordingly at that time.

Membership Policy Certification

Lawyers who routinely represent plaintiffs in product liability actions are ineligible for membership in PLAC. Lawyers who are members of firms which routinely represent plaintiffs in product liability matters are ineligible for membership.

It is the policy of PLAC that neither Sustaining members nor their firms will represent plaintiffs against Corporate members in product liability litigation involving death, personal injury, property damage, or economic loss. This is true regardless of the theory of law upon which the action is premised and regardless of whether, under a particular state's law, the action is regarded as a "product liability" action. The Policy does not apply to claims for contribution and/or indemnity arising out of product liability actions, or to product liability actions between Corporate members.

With respect to subrogation actions, the policy applies to Sustaining members as written. However, with respect to a Sustaining member's law firm, the policy precludes the regular and routine representation of plaintiffs in subrogation actions, but not the occasional representation. Additionally, with respect to those law firms of Sustaining members that do handle on occasion a plaintiff's subrogation action, it is the obligation of the Sustaining member to ensure that PLAC materials and access to the PLAC website is unavailable to the lawyers representing plaintiffs in those subrogation actions. Further, to the extent that a law firm of a Sustaining member represents a plaintiff in a subrogation action against a PLAC member, the Sustaining member is responsible for taking reasonable steps to know that fact.

In situations where Sustaining members are requested to represent a plaintiff in product liability litigation governed by this policy against a Corporate member, they are required to abide by the following procedure:

- 1. A list of PLAC's Corporate members will be included as part of the Sustaining member's firm conflict of interest checks.
- 2. Before any litigation governed by this policy is initiated by a sustaining member or his firm against a PLAC Corporate member, notice of the action will be given to the Corporate member.
- 3. The Sustaining member and the Corporate member should then attempt to resolve the matter between themselves.

- 4. In the event that satisfactory resolution of the matter is not attained, the Sustaining member or Corporate member may submit the matter to the PLAC Board of Directors for resolution in accord with the Board's judgment as to the best interests of the PLAC organization and its membership. The Board of Directors also reserves the right to determine, in its sole discretion, when the representation of subrogation plaintiffs has in fact become "regular and routine."
- 5. An opportunity to be heard will be provided to the parties.
- 6. The determination of the PLAC Board of Directors shall be final. Resolution of the matter may include voluntary withdrawal of a sustaining member from PLAC, or expulsion of the Sustaining member from PLAC.
