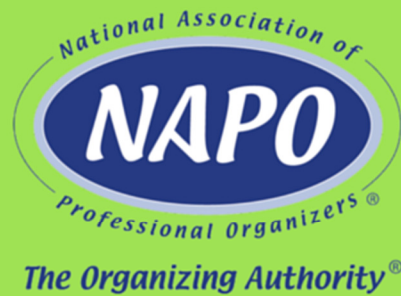

Chris McKenry has two ways of helping clients to get and stay organized. Returning to Knoxville in 2014, after 14 years in Los Angeles, Chris changed the name of his professional organizing business to Well-Kept Spaces. The organizing firm specializes in residential organizing and move management. McKenry's organizing projects have reached from Rancho Santa Fe in southern California to the Hamptons in New York.

Chris is also the Chief Organizing Officer at Closets by McKenry. For over 10 years McKenry offered storage design through his organizing firm. In 2015, Chris opened a separate business – Closets by McKenry. Using his home as his studio, clients are able to see examples of his work which includes custom designs for the closet, pantry, laundry, home office, craft room, and garage.

His start in the organizing field began in 2000 when he left his family's Tennessee poultry distribution business in 2000 to relocate to Los Angeles. Immediately he discovered the National Association of Professional Organizers (NAPO) and started *Get It Together LA!* Chris was president of NAPO-LA and from 2009-2011 he served on the NAPO Board of Directors. During his tenure as NAPO-LA President, McKenry created the Los Angeles Organizing Awards – the event that made “organizing swanky” according to Oprah's Peter Walsh. Two other events were started under Chris' leadership; the Los Angeles Organizing Expo and NAPO-LA Leadership Forum.

The award winning organizer has received the NAPO Shining Star Award, awards from the West Hollywood Chamber of Commerce and the Best Closet Design and Raising the Bar Awards at past Los Angeles Organizing Awards.

Chris McKenry has been seen on television in Knoxville and LA, heard on national radio and featured in The Oprah Magazine, Women's Day, LA Weekly and the Knoxville News-Sentinel. He loves to share the virtues of being organized wherever he goes and mentoring fellow NAPO members as they grow their business.
