U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OFFICE BUILDING ADDRESSES

Metro Station: Capitol South (Blue/Orange/Silver lines)

- **Cannon House Office Building**, 1st Street and Independence Ave SE
The first number corresponds to floor/level (e.g. Cannon 304 would be located on the 3rd floor/level).
- **Longworth House Office Building**, Independence and New Jersey Ave SE
The second number corresponds to floor/level (e.g. Longworth 1607 would be located on the 6th floor/level.)
- **Rayburn House Office Building**, Independence Avenue & South Capitol St SW
The second number corresponds to floor/level (e.g. Rayburn 2411 would be located on the 4th floor/level.)

U.S. SENATE OFFICE BUILDING ADDRESSES

Metro Station: Union Station (Red Line)

- **Russell Senate Office Building**, 1st and C Streets NE
- **Dirksen Senate Office Building**, 1st and C Streets NE
- **Hart Senate Office Building**, 2nd and C Streets NE

The first number of Senate room addresses corresponds to the floor/level in all of the buildings (Russell, Dirksen, and Hart). Addresses will be listed SR, SD, or SH depending on which building they are located.

As a reminder, Capitol Hill police officers posted at all entrances and staff are always happy to provide directions too.
