



PTGF Convention & Exam Scholarship Application Instructions

The Piano Technicians Guild Foundation offers up to eight Convention & Exam Scholarships each year. These scholarships cover both registration and one exam fee. Previous applicants who did not receive a scholarship are welcome to reapply.

To be considered, an applicant must:

- **Have passed two RPT exams**
- **Take the third test at the upcoming PTG convention**

The following supporting documents are required for application submission:

- A detailed resume, which should include
 - Details concerning your training in piano technology, e.g., attendance at a formal course of study, correspondence course(s), apprenticeship, mentoring
 - Work history, including other work as well as piano technology
 - Dates of PTG and chapter membership
 - Chapter involvement, including attendance at meetings and other activities
 - Attendance to date at PTG seminars and conferences
 - Attendance to date at the PTG Annual Convention
 - Any other information you consider pertinent to the application
- Two signed letters of recommendation from individuals with knowledge of your character and abilities
- A personal statement (500 word limit) describing why you should be considered for this scholarship including financial need and career plans.

For online registration, supporting documents must be in PDF format for upload. Apply securely online at ptgf.org in the Scholarships section.

For mail-in registration, the applicant should submit a completed copy of the application form (photocopies accepted), along with the required supporting documents. You are responsible for sending application items to:
