The RACI was founded in 1917 and originally called the Australian Chemical Institute. It received a Royal Charter in 1932 and a revision in the Royal Charter in 1953 allowed the name to be changed to Royal Australian Chemical Institute. The RACI became an incorporated association in 2000 representing the interests of those who work within the chemical sciences.


