

Michael P. Accordino, D.Ed., CRC, LMHC

Dr. Accordino is professor and Graduate Coordinator in the Rehabilitation and Disability Studies Department of Springfield College. He is president-elect of the National Council on Rehabilitation Education. He has worked in the field of psychiatric rehabilitation for 7 years and has been a rehabilitation educator for eighteen years. Dr. Accordino will be sharing information on relationships with other professionals and current concerns of the profession, as the impact of the CORE-CACREP merger and its affect on the profession, as well as insight and opportunities available for the IARP and NCRE to work together collectively for the future.

Lauren Milligan, Founder- ResuMAYDAY

Lauren Milligan is Founder, Head Resume Expert and Job Coach at ResuMAYDAY. She is considered a high-level expert in the area of career advancement and serves as a career advisor to many Chicago-area professional groups. "The Story Behind the Story" -Resume Revamp Secrets and Strategies will be her first presentation. Lauren will offer information on how to distinguish and market yourself within the market, based on professional goals. She will also discuss the benefits of using LinkedIn profiles, career transition obstacles in regard to cover letters and resumes, and thought provoking job search strategies. During her second session, Ms. Milligan will be reviewing methods on applying job search skills to clients of Vocational Rehabilitation Counselors and provide specific examples relative to a case study.

David R. Strauser, Ph.D

Dr. Strauser received his PhD in Rehabilitation Psychology from University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1995. He is a Professor in the Department of Kinesiology and Community Health at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign — where he also directs the Work and Disability Lab. He is one of six members elected to the Sloan Family Institute section on Work and Disability. Dr. Strauser will introduce the importance of leveraging social capital and promoting positive social roles as means to increase post-injury earning capacity. He will provide specific strategies and insight designed to maximize earning capacity.

Valerie Moreno-Tucker has her Master's degree in Rehabilitation Counselling. She has over 20 years of experience working with disability services, including job placement, sign language interpreting, rehabilitation counseling, vocational evaluation and assessment. Valerie will discuss the emerging area of services within the rehabilitation spectrum as it pertains to individuals in the 14 to 22-year-old category and identify three ways in which rehabilitation professionals can enhance the transition process within this age bracket.
