Organizational Member - QRIMA/RIMS

You are employed by a company in which you are responsible for risk management and your employer is not eligible for associate membership status. Your membership is in the name of your employer, and you must include yourself and any delegates from the company that employs you as members. All delegates will benefit from the privileges offered by RIMS and QRIMA and, as organizational members, all delegates from the company that employs you can sit on the board of directors of the Association.

Individual Member - QRIMA/RIMS

You are a risk management professional employed full-time by a company that is not eligible for associate membership status. This membership offers you the same advantages as that of an organizational member, including the right to sit on the Board of Directors of the Association.

Associate Member - QRIMA/RIMS

You provide products or services to those in the risk management profession (eg. you are a broker, underwriter, consultant, attorney, accountant, or actuary). You must register individually, and you will benefit from both RIMS and QRIMA member status. As an Associate Member, you also have the right to sit on the board of directors of the Association or participate on a subcommittee.

Associate Member - QRIMA Only

This membership is offered to any person providing products or services to those in the risk management profession; you are not eligible as a delegate of an organizational member and do not wish to become an associate member of RIMS.
