Donna Grieve, is the Risk Manager for Red River College and has been an employee with RRC in several capacities for 23 years. Her background is in Occupational Health & Safety, Disability Management and Risk Management. She has also been a certified St. John Ambulance First Aid instructor for the past three years, teaching mostly to staff members of RRC who now has 275 certified "first aiders" throughout the college.

Donna will be speaking about the new AED legislation and the importance of having an AED at your work place site as well as providing training for your staff in the use, maintenance and operation of this equipment and how it also becomes a Human Resource Risk Control for mitigating work related injuries and related health issues.

Donna will also be providing a hands on demonstration of using an AED in a mock emergency life-threatening cardiac situation.
