Prior to taking up this post, Paul spent three years in Dubai as the Regional Security Information Manager for Middle East and Eastern and Southern Africa, managing all security assessments and reporting for that region. In this role, Paul was a core member of the crisis management teams handling several major security escalations that led to mass evacuations, including from South Sudan, Libya, Iraq, Yemen and Turkey. Over the five years before he joined the team in Dubai, Paul worked in Singapore with Control Risks' Global Risk Analysis department, and prior to that with the joint venture from its inception in 2008 in various analytical and editorial capacities.

In those roles Paul authored and contributed to numerous in-depth analytical reports on topics and countries ranging from West Africa to East Asia to global cyber security threats.

Before joining Travel Security Services, Paul completed his master's degree in International Political Economy at Singapore's prestigious Rajaratnam School of International Studies. He has travelled extensively on all continents, and spent 16 years living in Asia.
