So What's the Big Deal with Space?

The May speaker is Robby Gains who is an engineering graduate from Texas A&M. He was a "Pad Rat" at the Cape Canaveral Air Force Launch Pad 41 where he prepared the pad for the launching of spy satellites and the Mars Rover. He is on the Houston Board of Directors of the National Space Society, a member of the Planetary Society and a founding member of the Challenger Learning Center. In January, Robby was named as one of NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL) Solar System Ambassadors.

Robby's presentation will address the wonders of space and the excitement of exploration. The Space Presentation is designed to educate, entertain, and celebrate all aspects of Space and Space activities.

For example, did you know that five years ago astronomers only speculated that there "might" be planets orbiting other stars. Today there are sixty seven known planets outside our solar system. Recently, the first solar system outside our own system was discovered. Even more interesting is the fact that twelve of these planets orbit their suns in the habitable zone, the same distance Earth and Mars orbit our sun. So not only are there sixty seven new planets, but there are twelve that could support life as we know it!
