- Update on this year's Mentoring Program – 90 students enrolled in Vaughan Institute and 26 students have been accepted into the Mentoring program with approximately 30 Mentors available. Great Year!!
- Aaron gave a report on the 8 students who attended the GIS Annual Conference in Charlotte, North Carolina.

- Hal presented the checks for the business card drawing held in September.
