Officers Meeting 10/8/14 Meeting Minutes

Minutes for the 9/10/14 meeting were reviewed and approved as presented

There was no other business presented.

The treasurer's report was confined to a review of the Sept. balances due to Angie's absence. And a reporting of the Chapter's \$4,200 contribution to the U of I Foundation for contribution to the 8 RMI students attendance at the GIS conference in Dallas. This Conf. took place last weekend and the GIS chapter received two awards at the conf. This contribution was budgeted at \$5,250. Several students had job interviews, and two had second round interviews.

Hal requested that we conduct a review of Budget to Actual results at the Nov., April, and June or July Officers planning meetings.

Hal reported that the Chapter will be posting a new Student Spotlight for Yu Cao for the month of Oct.

And also reported that the Chapter Sponsor's Profile has been developed and CorVel's profile has now been posted on the web site as the first one. We will change profiles each quarter.

1. Other Old Business

Tom Ohrt reported that Rockwell Collins has agreed to create a Chapter Members Spotlight to be posted on our web site.

Tom also reported that he has booked Blackstone as the location for our Jan and March 2015 meetings.

The officers discussed the probable future of the Chapter and discussed the interest of the current officers continuing to serve beyond this chapter year. There appears to be at least three officers that will continue to serve, and we will work on creating a ballot for April 2015 election of officers.

Hal reported that FEI (Financial Executives International) has approached him about a possible joint meeting. He has given their representative a copy of our program

schedule for their consideration. And there was some discussion of considering joint meetings with CPCU, Claims Association and others.

It was also decided to allocate 5 or 10m minutes to each officers meeting to discuss and start to create a list of optional program ideas for the next Chapter year.

The officers discussed having a Chapter Sponsor's appreciation event and it was decided to combine this with our December Holiday event.

With the absence of the treasurer, Hal paid for the Radisson bill of \$ 477.78 and will request reimbursement from Angie.
