Open Ledger: Managing Blockchain-Related Risks

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Blockchain technology and crypto currencies were thrust into the public spotlight late last year following BitCoin’s sudden and dramatic appreciation in value. Since then, the potential impact on this promising but often misunderstood technology has been the subject of much discussion in the risk management community. In this session, we will provide an overview on blockchain technology, examine how some companies have already integrated it into their operations, and discuss how some insurance programs might (or might not) respond to blockchain-related risks.
