Beginning Tuesday, September 19, 2017*

ARM 56 - Risk Financing

The New York Chapter of the Risk and Insurance Management Society, Inc. will sponsor the ARM-56 Course, "Risk Financing," beginning, Tuesday, September 19, 2017.



ARM-56 provides an overview of the risk financing with a focus on estimating hazard risk, transferring hazard risk through insurance, self-insurance plans, retrospective rating plans, reinsurance, captive insurance, contractual risk transfer, transferring financial risk, and transferring hazard risk to the capital markets.

This course will prepare participants to take The Institutes' ARM-56 examination. After passing the examinations for ARM 54, ARM 55, ARM 56, and The Ethical Guidelines, candidates will be awarded the Associate in Risk Management designation by The Institutes. Examinations can be taken in any order, so students may enroll in this ARM-56 course and take the exam prior to completing 54 or 55.

Classes will begin on Tuesday, September 19, 2017, and will be held from 6:00 to 8:00 pm on Tuesday evenings at the RIMS office at 5 Bryant Park. There will be a total of 14 sessions to prepare students to take the standardized examination. The instructor is David Shluger, MBA, ARM, CIRM of Zurich North America.
