

*NY Chapter of RIMS Offers ARM 55 Virtual and In-Person Course  
Beginning Thursday, January 17, 2019*

**ARM 55 - Risk Assessment and Treatment**

The New York Chapter of the Risk and Insurance Management Society, Inc. will sponsor the ARM 55 Course, "Risk Assessment and Treatment" beginning, Thursday, January 17, 2019.



ARM 55 will examine the different types of risk and teach how to effectively assess and treat these risks. This course will prepare participants to take The Institutes' ARM 55 examination. After passing the examinations for ARM 54, ARM 55, ARM 56, and The Ethical Guidelines, candidates will be awarded the Associate in Risk Management (ARM) designation by The Institutes.

The program will be taught by a seasoned live instructor; the virtual sessions use Cisco's WebEx platform; and you get the added benefit of two in-person sessions. The WebEx link will be emailed to all registrants prior to the first class. The platform can support a maximum of 24 students.

The course begins on Thursday, January 17, 2019 and will be held from 6:00 to 8:00 pm on Thursday evenings for 9 sessions, including an additional comprehensive review session. The two in-person classes will be held on January 17 and March 21, 2019 at the local RIMS office. Both in-person classes will be conducted via the WebEx for those students unable to attend in person. Further details will be provided to students. The instructor is David Shluger, ARM, CIRM, MBA of Zurich North America. He has previously taught ARM courses on behalf of the RIMS New York Chapter, has 10 years of experience in Risk Management and Insurance and is a 2018 Business Insurance Breakout Award winner.
