Decision Support Applications: What Risk Managers should understand about the Process - Predictive Analytics

Risk managers should understand how predictive analysis is utilized and how it will affect their claim handling process. Our industry has developed a long list of techniques to assist claim adjusters to make the best decisions—training, in service education, on-line reference tools—but we are just now adopting the most effective new tools—decision support applications. This presentation will review the major types of decision support tools, often referred to under the misleading term, predictive analytics, and how they can be developed and socialized into the claim process to enhance the accuracy and timeliness of decision making. These new applications can change every aspect of the claim process by pointing out which claimants are likely to litigate or commit fraud, where to find more subro opportunities, how to deploy medical and RTW management interventions for optimal impact and even how to enhance reserve techniques.
