**Environmental Clean Ups In Oregon: How A New Oregon Statute May Reduce Disputes In
Obtaining Insurance Coverage For Cleaning Up The Portland Harbor
And Other Environmental Sites In Oregon**

The recent passage of the OECAA Amendment to the Oregon Environmental Cleanup Assistance Act, ORS 465.475 et seq.
