- Northern Trust Balance: \$38,852.50

- Balance as of December 2015: \$80,998.81
- The Assistant Treasuer: George Googla did a Cash Flow Estimate through June 2016 per Marie's request; The estimated balance through June 2016 is \$124,908 (this based on the Balance as of December, Plus an additional \$44K in revenue from the Golf Outing. Meetings should be operated at \$2,500, Hines should be at \$8k.
