HISTORY

Local and family-owned since 1952 when founded by the late Joseph Koury. Koury Corporation has quietly and steadily transformed the landscape of Greensboro, North Carolina. Soon after, the name "Grandover" was conceived. The East Course, the first of two championship golf courses opened in March 1996. Just over a year later the West Course opened in May 1997. The Resort, Conference Center and Spa opened in February 1999.

Since then, Grandover Resort and its team of associates has been welcoming conference groups, social events, golf tournaments, as well as individual business and leisure travelers to experience our world-class services and amenities.

Grandover has recently completed the renovation of all guest rooms. All rooms feature large picture windows, décor that conveys the casual elegance of the Resort including coffee/ tea makers, robes, small refrigerators, complimentary wi-fi, 42" flat panel televisions and a stylish bathroom with a large rainfall showerhead, luxurious linens and a vast assortment of Gilchrist & Soames amenities.

Golf at Grandover

Golf at Grandover is a public, PGA golf facility featuring a practice area, Golf Pro Shop and two challenging 18-hole courses; The East Course and the West Course. Designed by David Graham and Gary Parks, world-renowned golf architects. Golf at Grandover is dedicated to delivering the area's best service and top-quality golf course facilities.

West Course – Opened in May 1997, the West Course is formed with the naturally rolling terrain and elevation changes found in the Piedmont of North Carolina. A links style layout flows away from the resort for the first nine holes and returns for the inward nine. The West Course measures 6800 yards from the championship tees.

East Course – Opened in March 1996, the East Course was designed by Gary Panks and David Graham. Many of the holes were designed to give a stadium-effect around

them. The tree-lined fairways provide a seasonal blaze of color offering guests the feeling of being in a nature preserve in America's heartland of golf.
