The Risk Management Association (RMA) promotes an enterprise approach to risk management that focuses on credit risk, market risk, operational risk, securities lending, and regulatory issues. Founded in 1914, RMA was originally called the Robert Morris Associates, named after American patriot Robert Morris, a signer of the Declaration of Independence. Morris, the principal financier of the Revolutionary War, helped establish our country's banking system.

Today, RMA has approximately 2,500 institutional members and 16,000 individuals, known as RMA Associates located throughout North America and financial centers in Europe, Australia and Asia.

To assist members in advancing sound risk principles, RMA keeps members informed and provides access to industry information through its website (www.rmahq.org); publishes The RMA Journal and a variety of newsletters, books, and statistics; conducts workshops and seminars; holds several conferences, and annual convention (Annual Risk Management Conference); and has numerous committees working on a variety of projects.
