Applications must be submitted by the troupe director only and are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. As long as funds are available, qualified students will be inducted as soon as possible following grant approval and notification. If funds are not available at the time a school is approved for a grant or inductions are submitted, the school will be notified and added to a waiting list until funds become available.

NOTE: By submitting this application, the troupe director confirms that the students listed are eligible for induction and have demonstrated financial need warranting assistance to pay for their one-time induction fees. The grant offsets \$15 per Thespian induction and \$7 per Junior Thespian induction. The school agrees to pay for the remainder of the fees not covered by the grant. This grant will cover fee assistance for the listed students *only*, and all students listed must be submitted for induction *at the same time* using the online induction system. Instructions will be provided along with notification of grant approval.
