What will lunch look like?

Box lunches will be available for pickup in the ballroom at 10:00 AM.

What bathrooms are available?

Golf Course Etiquette

For your safety and to ensure that our golfers are not distracted while playing the course please pay attention to the following guidelines when riding around the course.

- Be aware of your surroundings at all times.
- Please speak quietly when riding around in the golf cart with another person.
- Do not under any circumstances, drive through when golfers are hitting a ball.
- Stop and wait for golfers to hit the ball(s) and watch where they are going before continuing on through the course.
- This means when they are teeing off, putting or just playing through.
- Stay on the paths at all times when on the golf cart.
- Before you back up, make sure no one is playing within earshot.

Rules for 18-Hole Outing

- This golf outing will be played using the “Scramble” format. On every hole, each player hits a tee shot; the foursome selects the best shot and everyone plays from that spot. This procedure continues until the ball is holed out.
- Each golfer needs to have at least two of their tee shots used as their foursome’s best drive.
- Tees - Men will tee off from the white tees and ladies from the gold tees.
- Mulligan Tickets – Each golfer receives two Mulligan tickets. Each mulligan ticket is good for a single re-hit. Each Mulligan ticket can only be used once on the course.
- Putting Strings – Each foursome receives 2 “Putting Strings”(1 string in each cart). Refer to the directions found on the back of the Putting String envelopes.
- Hand Iron - In the spirit of fun, each team is to use one “throw” or “toss” during the round. This “Hand Iron” is used in lieu of a golf shot, but cannot be used when on a green. Every team member must throw or toss the ball instead of hitting it with a golf club. You then play the ball that was tossed closest to the hole. Please mark your scorecard on which hole that you used the “throw” or “toss.”
- Have fun!!!

Length of Play

Given the nature of this golf outing, please plan that it will take up to 6 hours to complete all 18 holes. You should have completed 9 holes by 1:30 PM.

Putting Contest Rules

- During the golf outing, each registered golfer is invited to make one attempt to sink a qualifying 10' putt.
- Anyone that sinks their 10' qualifying putt is invited to return to the putting green at 5:00 PM to compete in the elimination rounds.

5:00 PM Elimination Rounds:

- Qualifying golfers should bring their own putter and golf ball.
- All golfers who made their qualifying 10' putt must be present at the start of the elimination rounds to remain in the putting contest.
- No practice putts are allowed once the first elimination round has started or during the qualifying round.
- Each pre-qualified golfer will have one chance to sink a 20' putt.
- Golfers that sink their 20' putt will advance to the next round where they will attempt to sink a 30' putt. Winners of the 30' putt elimination round will advance to the 40' putt round.
- These elimination rounds will continue until just one golfer remains.
- The winner of the elimination rounds will have one chance to sink a 50' putt to win \$5,000.
