Format

Scramble/Captain's Choice Tournament

Format: Each member of the team tees off from the starting hole. The best tee shot is chosen through consensus among the team. The spot of the best tee shot is marked with a golf tee or ball marker. Players must pick up their golf balls and hit from within one club length of the newly marked spot no closer to the hole. Team members continue selecting the best shot until one player hits the ball in the hole. The team score is the total of the best shots. For any teams that have 3 players, the remaining team members will alternate hitting 2 shots per hole. NOTE: MAX SCORE OF BOGEY!!!

Tees

Men will play from the WHITE Tees. Ladies will play from the RED Tees.

Rules of Play

U.S.G.A. Rules will govern all play. Reference Local Rules, if needed.

You may move the ball one club length, no closer to the hole, anywhere on the golf course. A ball in the rough must stay in the rough; a ball in the sand must stay in the sand, etc.

Ties: Ties will be broken by a scorecard playoff starting with the back nine total, then the last 6 holes, then the last 3 holes and then #18... Reference Appendix 1; 11-C in the USGA Rules of Golf.

Ground Under Repair

All newly sodded areas will be played as ground under repair.

All areas defined by white lines will be played as ground under repair.

All drainage and irrigation lines where the ground is sunken in over the line will be played as ground under repair.

If your ball lies in the landscaped area on 17, near 11 tee, play as ground under repair.

Out of Bounds

Out of Bounds is defined by white stakes. NOTE: "Local Stroke & Distance" Rule in effect.

Penalty Areas

Defined by yellow or red stakes or lines. The right side of Hole #16 is a Red Penalty Area. If you hit into this penalty area and find your ball in a property owner's yard you must take a drop outside of the penalty area according to the Red Penalty Area Rules.

Environmentally Protected Areas

Environmentally Protected Areas are defined by red or yellow stakes with a green top. You MAY NOT enter these areas and MUST take a drop.

Contests

Closest to the Pin: Holes #8, #12 | Longest Drive in Fairway: Holes #1 Women, #18 Men Putting Contest: During Round on Putting Green, when going from hole 18 to hole 1

COVID Recommendations:

Recommending use of E-Z Lyft Ball Retriever on flagstick to remove ball from hole. We are encouraging groups to refrain from removing the flagsticks at any point. Please limit the sharing of golf balls, clubs, rakes, and sand bottles. Please be mindful of social distancing and shared touchpoint precautions.

Restroom Combination: Press 2 & 4 simultaneously, release, press 3, release and open door.
