- Most of our chapter members are the technology decision makers.
- We are expecting more than 128 golfers including SIM CIO members and prospective Executive members.
- Tournament participants are CIOs; their direct reports and/or peers in their organization; and other high-level business executives. The other category of attendees comes from the sponsors. Sponsor invitees are typically senior-level and account managers from their company; customers they want to offer a round as a "thank you" or prospects that they are "courting" and want to develop a closer relationship with by offering a golf event on an exclusive course.

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Participation Rules

In order to be fair to all sponsors, we ask that all sponsors abide by the following guidelines:

- Each sponsorship is for a single company. No sponsorships can be split by multiple companies.
- Non-sponsoring vendors will not be allowed to attend the event unless they are a SIM Member.
- There must be at least 2 IT practitioners on each sponsor team.
- Any last-minute substitutes to a team must abide by the above rules.
- Sponsor team list should be submitted by April 10th.
- There cannot be any liquor brought onto the grounds or served at the individual hole stations per TABC and club rules.
- Any separate games or activities at a sponsor hole must be pre-approved.

We ask that all sponsoring vendors act professionally and abide by the above guidelines. Failure to do so will affect their opportunity to sponsor future SIM events.
