

FEDLINK continues to work toward strategic sourcing and welcomes the involvement of all DOD libraries.

FEDLINK has been designated the lead agent for the strategic sourcing of information resources.

FEDLINK was the first agency outside of GSA named, and so far the only legislative branch agency.

FEDLINK and the Library of Congress are continuing progress on the Federal library collection analysis project by involving more STEM libraries and by developing a second project for the DOD MECC libraries.
