1. All Authors' name, email addresses, and organizations
2. Identification of Corresponding Author
3. Content Type:
 - Technical Paper – Peer Reviewed
 - Student Paper
 - Ship Production Paper or Presentation
 - Technical and Research (T&R) Program Session (Paper, Presentation or Discussion)
 - Special Content
4. Faces: Which Face(s) of SNAME does your abstract primarily pertain to? You can select more than one Face to describe the intended audience for your paper (for a further description of each Face of SNAME, [click here](#)). This information will help the committee define tracks for the convention.
