"THE NEW OSV CHEMICAL CODE, HOW IT WILL AFFECT OFFSHORE SUPPORT VESSELS"

In the past we had the IMO Resolution A673.(16) Guidelines for the Transport and Handling of Limited Amounts of Hazardous and Noxious Liquid Substances in Bulk in Offshore Vessels in 1989. The changes on the Chemical Code on 1 January 2007 suddenly increased dramatically the number of vessels that came under these requirements.

With continued development of fields and cargoes, an updated requirement to carry more cargoes with larger quantities the IMO Resolution A.1122(30) Code for the Handling of Limited Amounts of Hazardous and Noxious Liquid Substances in Bulk in Offshore Vessels (OSV Chemical Code) came into effect on 1 July 2018, initially an advisor but later will become mandatory.
