If you would like to pay with a check, made payable to South Shore Realtors®, please mail it, along with your invoice, to South Shore Realtors®, 48 Schoosett St. Pembroke, MA 02359. Envelope must be postmarked by January 1, 2026. Our Pembroke office has a mailslot to the left of the front door if dropping dues off in person when office is closed.

## **INSTRUCTIONS TO PAY ONLINE:**

- 1) Visit <u>www.SouthShoreRealtors.com</u>
- **2)** Log in: NRDS#/M1# (don't know it? Click <u>HERE</u>): Password: your last name with initial capital letter unless you've previously changed it.
- 3) To access your invoice, click one of the following:
- \* Main header "2026 Membership Dues Invoices Now Available"
- \* The green "View and Pay Invoices" button on left under your profile image
- 4) Click "Pay Dues" or the order item itself "2026 South Shore Realtors", Inc. Annual Dues"
- 5) Click continue.
  - Note for Primary REALTORS®: Primary REALTORS® have five payment plan options that will show up in your member portal. Read details of each option to understand installment due dates and your payment responsibility. If you choose an option with installments rather than paying in full, the payments will be deducted automatically from the provided card on the specified dates of the plan. You will be charged a penny of your 2026 South Shore Realtors® Local Dues upon sign-up to ensure your card has properly tied to your account. Once the first payment date of an option has passed, sign up for that option will close. Deadlines are shown on each option in the portal.
- 6) Agree to terms and conditions and hit "continue"
- 7) Review order details and click "Pay Now"
- **8)** Enter your card information and follow the prompts until you have reached the payment completion page. You will receive a receipt via email.
