Dwayne Purvis has been practicing reservoir engineering since 1995. He spent 18 years as a reservoir engineering consultant at Cawley, Gillespie and Associates and then as Executive Vice President at The Strickland Group. Most recently he served Jetta Operating in Fort Worth as Reservoir Engineering Manager and Reserves Manager before starting his own consulting practice.
