#### 1. Website Strategy (Josh Haberer)

First draft of the website is available; lots of feedback received. John de Wardt and Josh recommend forming a workgroup to work through the feedback, specify content – *contact Josh if you can help*. Site is close to launch, just needs more content. Fred will specify external groups that might review site (e.g., IADC, control companies).

# 2. Communications Team Update (Clint Chapman)

Update on demo for Denver, October 30; tests to be held July 27. Questions on what we will do with demo at the meeting. John DeW inquired if he could add a slot for the demo during the panel sessions – affirmative – can also use it as a lead-in to workshop next year (demo of OPC UA). Shasta asked about needed AV equip; Clint to respond.

Good start on definition of interfaces for phase 3 (how much needs to be custom or can be OPC UA).

### 3. IADC and DSATS Standards Workgroup (Fred Florence)

IADC set up workgroup – first list main tasks in drilling a well, and then indicate which tasks can/cannot be automated – IADC looking at functional specifications for automation and DSATS giving technical help – will be presented at IADC meeting in September in Jakarta.
