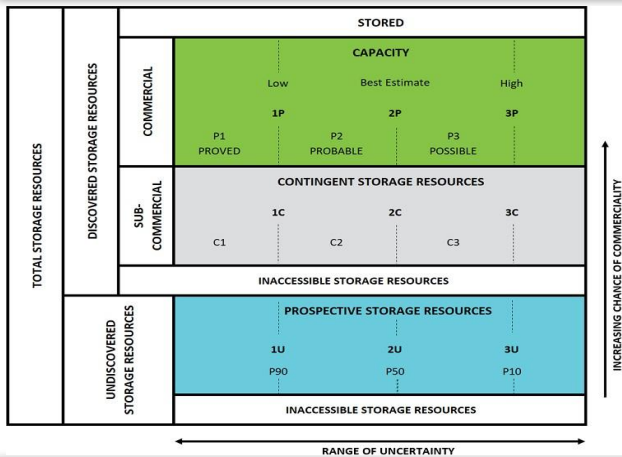

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- CSRC reviewed the UNFC-SRMS Bridging Document and provided comments prepared by the Expert Group on Resource Management which will be presented at [17th Session of the Expert Group on Resource Management | UNECE](#).
 - SRMS is to be recognized as 'an aligned system' to the UNFC system.
- Two new members have joined CSRC and are part of the Governance SC.
- Three new volunteers have been identified to join the Communications SC.
- First two of four chapters of the video training materials have been recorded and are under review.
- Training course delivered to Oklahoma Geological Society at the end of January.

IN PROGRESS

- Governance on training being established.
