

\$12,000 SPE SCHOLARSHIP

To encourage the pursuit of careers in the Oil and Gas Industry, the Fort Worth Section of the Society of Petroleum Engineers is excited to offer scholarships for students that are either entering their freshman year of college or are an undergraduate student already in college.

Undergraduate scholarships of up to \$3,000 per year are awarded annually and (once awarded) may be renewed through the recipient's senior year in college (up to \$12,000 in total).

Scholarships and renewals are contingent on the student:

- 1) Enrolling in and maintaining a full-time status in a curriculum leading to a degree in petroleum engineering or related engineering program that will lead to a career in the Oil and Gas Industry.
- 2) Achieving a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for each semester.

Failure to maintain these standards may result in a denial of renewal requests.

Students should be from Tarrant County or surrounding area (Erath, Hood, Johnson, Palo Pinto, Parker, Somervell, and Wise Counties). Candidates from outside this area will be considered on a case-by-case basis. First year applicants (rising freshmen) must provide a statement that it is their intent to enroll in a petroleum engineering or related engineering program at an accredited university that will lead to a career in the Oil and Gas Industry. Undergraduate applicants must provide an official transcript identifying their major course of study.

Applicants must be United States citizens or lawful permanent residents.

Submit at least two and maximum of three letters of recommendation. Make sure your references include your full name in their recommendation.

All letters must be received by the scholarship chairman **before** the April 15th deadline. Reference letters should be from SPE members who know you, employers, research leaders, or professors (in your major). Letters from high school instructors and counselors are also accepted for high school students. If you have had past internships, one of your reference letters should come from your internship supervisor if possible.

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6) AFFIRMATION

- a. This scholarship is contingent upon recipient being officially registered at an accredited university and enrolled in a curriculum leading to a degree in petroleum engineering or a directly related field that will lead to a career in the Oil and Gas Industry.
- b. An official transcript must be included in the application package. For college undergraduates, this must cover the last two semesters at a minimum.
- c. All the information in this application is required for you to receive consideration for this scholarship.
- d. The entire application package must be received on or before April 15th each year. Incomplete or late applications will NOT be considered.
