- A. Any scholarship awarded by the Salt Lake Petroleum Section of the Society of Petroleum Engineers is contingent upon the recipient being officially registered at an accredited university and **enrolled in a graduate program for engineering or geosciences discipline related to petroleum extraction.**
- B. **Scholarship applications need to be received no later than November 15, 2018** for consideration. Recipient of scholarship will be notified approximately 30 days after the application submittal deadline.
- C. If selected as a potential scholarship recipient, a personal letter of recommendation from a faculty advisor or administrator may be requested.
- D. All the information requested on this form shall be provided for consideration of scholarship. If the applicant desires to include additional information as part of the application, please do so by attaching supplemental pages.
- E. A scholarship check of \$2000 will be issued to the selected recipient during December 2018 for the collegiate year. A Social Security number (or tax ID number), proof of enrollment, and identification may be required before the check is delivered to the recipient.
