Know about Giovanni Paccaloni 2005 SPE International President

As mentioned in the inaugural issue about the forthcoming visit of Mr Giovanni Paccaloni, SPE international President 2005, to our section we bring you his brief bio. SPE Section meeting to welcome him has been scheduled on 1st of December 2005 at Windsor Hall, Le Meridien, New Delhi.

Giovanni Paccaloni currently serves as Senior Advisor at Eni Agip's headquarters in Milan. Since joining Eni Agip in 1971, Paccaloni has worked worldwide in various leadership roles, including Vice President, Corporate E&P Laboratories (1997-99); Vice President, Drilling and Production Optimization (2000-02; and Vice President of R&D and Technology Planning (2003).

An SPE member since 1986, Paccaloni served as SPE Director Europe and Africa Region during 1995-99 and was named an SPE Distinguished Member in 2000. He has served twice as Chairperson of the Italian Section and has played an active role in that section's governance for more than 15 years. His many SPE activities include service as Chairperson of the Forum Series Implementation Committee (1993-95), the Forum Series Coordinating Committee (1995-97) and the 1992 Forum Series in Europe Steering Committee. He served as an SPE Distinguished Lecturer during 1988-89 on the topic "Optimization of Matrix Stimulation Treatments."

Paccaloni is Honorary Professor at the Daqing Petroleum Institute (China) and the University of Guayaquil (Ecuador), and Visiting Professor at the Xian Shiyou University (China). During his career, he has authored and co-authored several technical papers, including articles published in JPT and SPEPE. Paccaloni holds an MS degree in industrial chemistry from the U. of Bologna.

The India Pavilion at the 18th World Petroleum Congress (WPC), Johannesburg, South Africa, was inaugurated this morning by Mr. S C Tripathi, the Secretary (designated Vice Minister), MoPNG, Government of India, who was also leading the Indian delegation at the Congress.



The thematic representation of 'Ahead with India – Partnership in Knowledge and Investment' was vibrantly presented at the Pavilion attracting delegates and visitors, who showed keen interest in the various developments projected in the Indian energy sector. Oil and Natural Gas Corporation limited i.e., ONGC was the nodal agency in organizing this pavilion.

Mr. Tripathi was accompanied by Mr. Talmiz Ahmed, Additional Secretary(IC), Mr. A K Jain, Director, Mr. V K Sibal, DG, DGH, Mr. S Behuria, C&MD, IOC, Mr. N K Mitra, Director (Offshore), ONGC (who is SPE New Delhi Section Chairperson 2005-06) and Mr. R S Butola, MD, OVL.

The Pavilion construct creatively represented upstream and downstream sector on either side with the central wheel of Ashoka Chakra, being the pivotal representation of growth in Indian energy sector. The dynamism of the stand was brought out by the broad pipeline structure that depicted India emerging as the hub for energy cooperation, with the cross border pipeline through Turkmenistan, Iran, Bangladesh and Myanmar.

India's growth as the fastest free market democracy, being the 6th Largest energy consumer in the world, having an annual GDP growth rate, which is the 4th largest in the world with investments in the oil & gas industry estimated at US\$ 90 billion, are all focal issues at the India Pavilion.



The Pavilion proudly displayed the national colours, served Indian cuisine, and had attractive hostesses in Indian attire, to make the entire experience of visiting the India Pavilion a memorable one.



After 57 Years of Perforating, Does it Still Have A Future?

October Section Meeting Preview

Abstract:

In the early 80's, perforating was 35 years old and many believed, and still do, that perforating was a mature science and that a hole-is-a-hole. This talk follows the progress of perforating from the early 80's to the present and will show that in the past 20 years, perforating technology has seen substantial progress. The result of this progress is directly related to improved well productivity. Perforating systems and downhole performance and their relation to increased well productivity will be discussed. The talk will end with a peek into the future.

Larry Behrmann has been associated with Schlumberger for more than 23 years. Presently, he is working as the Perforating Solutions Advisor for Middle East & Asia.

Larry's role is to provide the client with best perforating practices for all completion types (fracture, sand control/prevention, natural, carbonates, etc.). His main projects are implementing the PURE perforating process and perforating solutions in Middle East & Asia.

His major achievements include the following: joint research on perforation damage and cleanup with BP and ELF, (1985-1994), SPAN (Schlumberger Perforation and Analysis software), charge design, PURE (perforation for ultimate reservoir exploitation), and perforating requirements in unconsolidated sandstones & joint research with Mobil to optimize perforated/gravel pack completions.

Larry is the primary author of a chapter on "Perforating Requirements for Frac-and-Pack," a new SPE book to be published on Frac-and-Pack. He has been invited to give perforating seminars around the world for clients and SLB field locations. His reputation is that of one of the world's leading perforating experts.

He was invited by the SPE to be the discussion leader on perforation at the "Formation Damage Forum," 1992; Carbonate Workshop, 1997; and Fracturing Workshop, 2003.

Committee member: Perforating Forum, 1994; SPE/IADC Under Balance Conference, 2003; SPE ATW Maximizing Well Productivity, 2003; SPE Forum Extreme Completion Options for 2007 and Beyond, 2004; SPE ATW Sand Management, 2005

Publications: He has authored nearly 28 Technical Papers and has written a section on "Perforating for Fracture Stimulation" in the 3rd edition of the Dowell Stimulation Handbook.


