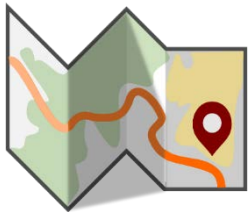

### **Bio of Rod Prosceno**

Rod Prosceno is currently a Managing Member for Grant Canyon Oil & Gas, LLC and Saddle Rim Energy (TX), LLC. Mr. Prosceno's current role is providing both management and engineering functions to the companies including direct management of field operations, engineering oversight of EOR reservoir processes, short term operational adjustments and long term development planning and financial team management.

Eugene Wadleigh is currently a Managing Member of Full-Spectrum Monitoring Inc (FSM), Grant Canyon Oil & Gas, LLC, and Saddle Rim Energy (TX), LLC. Mr. Wadleigh was instrumental in providing target selection for EOR projects presently operated by Grant Canyon.

Mr. Wadleigh is a Petroleum Engineer with 38 years' experience in exploration and production, most of which was with Marathon Oil. Gene has authored numerous articles and presentations on oil recovery and holds several patents in this area. He is a professional Engineer holding degrees in both geology and geological engineering from South Dakota School of Mines.
