ONLINE JOURNAL SITE FOR CAREER DEVELOPMENT FOR EXCEPTIONAL INDIVIDUALS

The electronic version of *Career Development for Exceptional Individuals* is available free online, exclusively to DCDT members through our agreement with SAGE Journals Online. If you have not previously activated your account, please follow the steps below.

To access the electronic version of *Career Development for Exceptional Individuals*:

1. Go to the *Career Development for Exceptional Individuals* site at <https://online.sagepub.com/cgi/activate/basic> .
2. For first time user, you will be prompted to enter your Member Number and select your society (DCDT) from a pull down menu.
3. After you enter your Member Number, select your society, and click "Submit," just follow the simple instructions on the screen. On the "Instructions" page, be sure to check your personal data, enter a username, and password, and click submit to confirm the activation. Do not click the Journal Title link until the confirmation process has been completed.
4. Once complete, click on CDEI journal link under "You have access to:"
5. To view current issue click on "Current Issue".
6. To select an issue from the archive, select "All Issues".
7. To search for articles, enter article title in "search this journal" search bar.

When returning to the site, click on "Sign In" at bar on top. If you forget your username or password, go to the "subscriptions" link on the left side of the page and look for the link "What to do if you forget your User Name and/or Password." You will be asked to provide some information about yourself. Upon confirmation of the information, the username of password will be emailed to you. If you require technical assistance, please contact the SAGE Journals Online technical assistance located on the top of the web page under "contact us."
