Purpose of the fit/gap process:

The functional fit/gap process is a tool to determine changes to the system, ensuring that your electronic system work for your institution.

How do you do this:

Identify where gaps in functionality exist by comparing your current business process requirements to system capabilities.

Fit Gap

Strategy Steps for Fit Gap

- 1) Confirm that Quali Protocols meets all current UMBC business processes/requirements
- 2) Identify all current business processes (create or formalize current procedures)
- 3) Identify functionality that enables improvements to current processes or updates your institution to current industry standards or regulations
- 4) Process changes (revising the business process to meet system requirements)
- 5) Prioritize ,Prioritize, Prioritize
- 6) Create a finalized assessment (fit/gap) document for your office and stakeholder

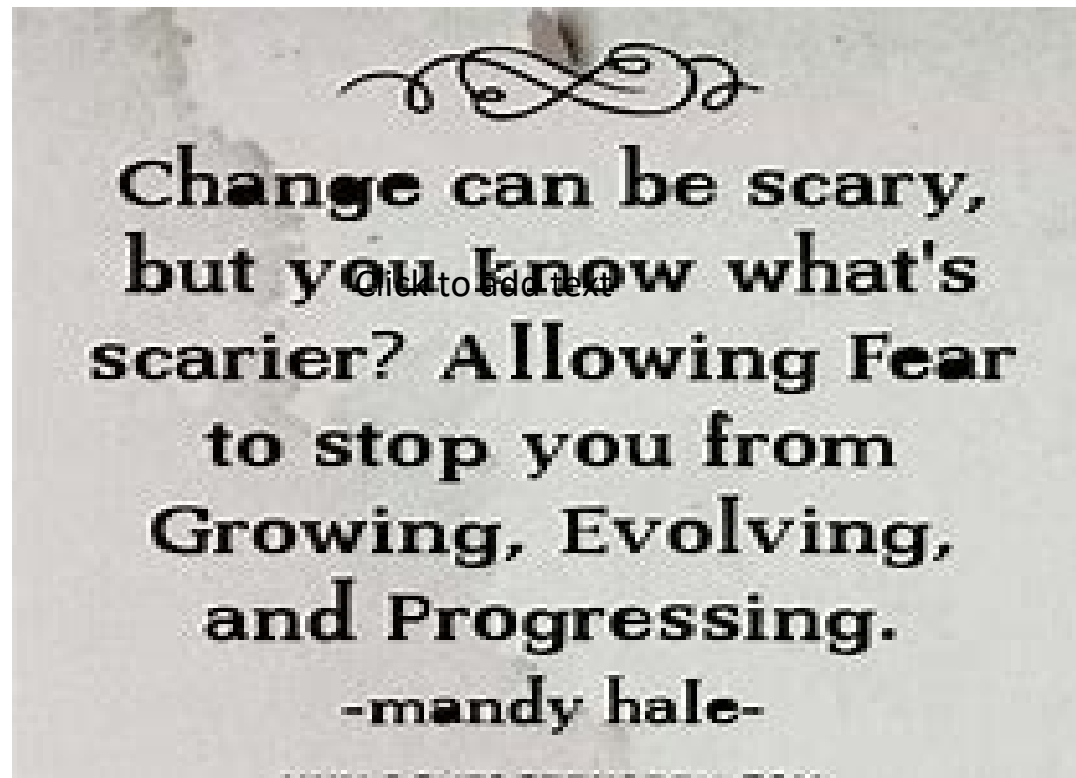

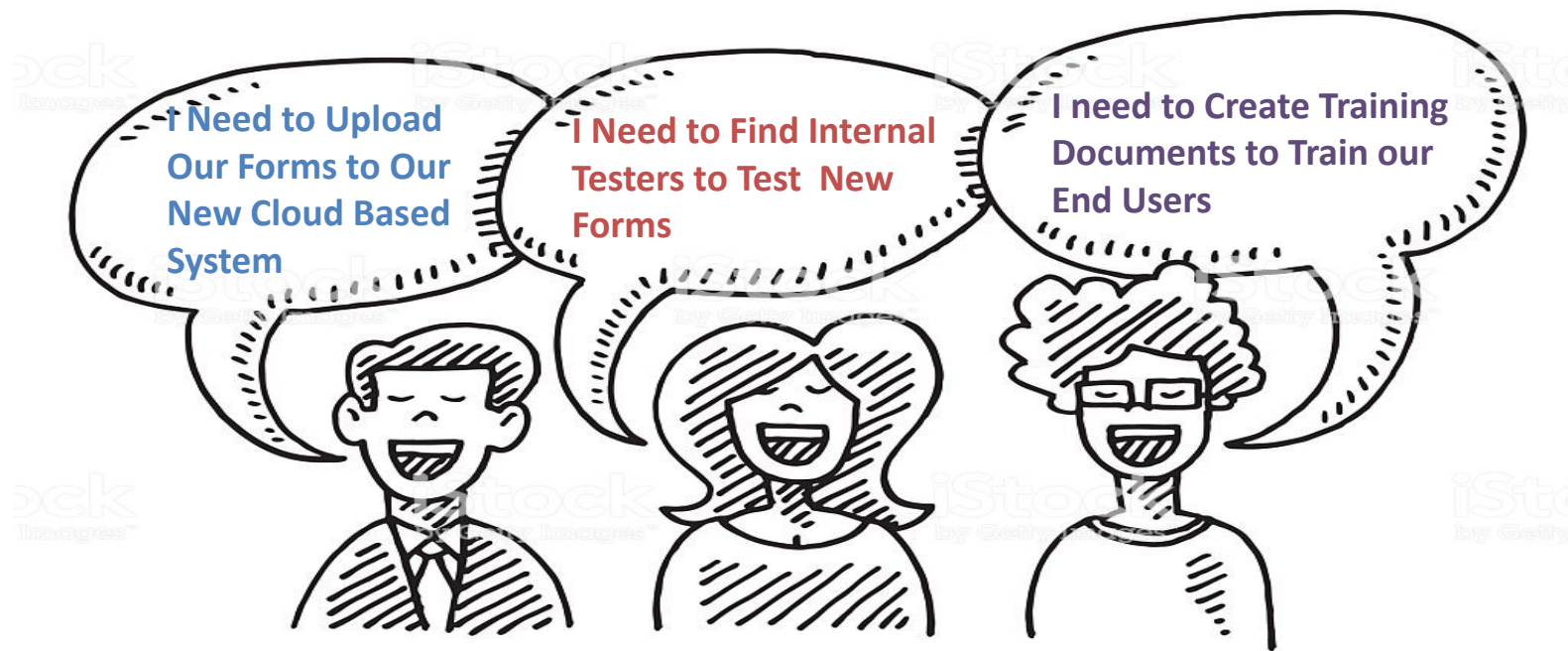
Getting the information out there



Configure submission within Kuali structure

- How do paper process and electronic processes converge
 - Forms remain the same only the effort has changed
- What efficiency efforts can we identify
 - Time savings in multiple areas
 - Submission, review, approval
 - How best to serve investigator needs
 - Training is Key usually requiring visits to lab or office (personalized)
 - Group sessions with reserved rooms (block of hours)

- Current SOP
 - Look at current SOP's to determine what we can use
 - Pre KUALI
 - Submissions were done online
 - PI's had moved away from paper but now we need to update them with cloud based platform
- New SOP – how to get them fit post KUALI
 - Most required minor tweaks
 - Training was key to implementation

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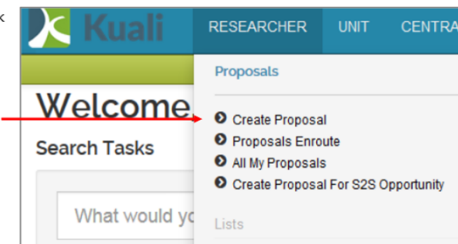

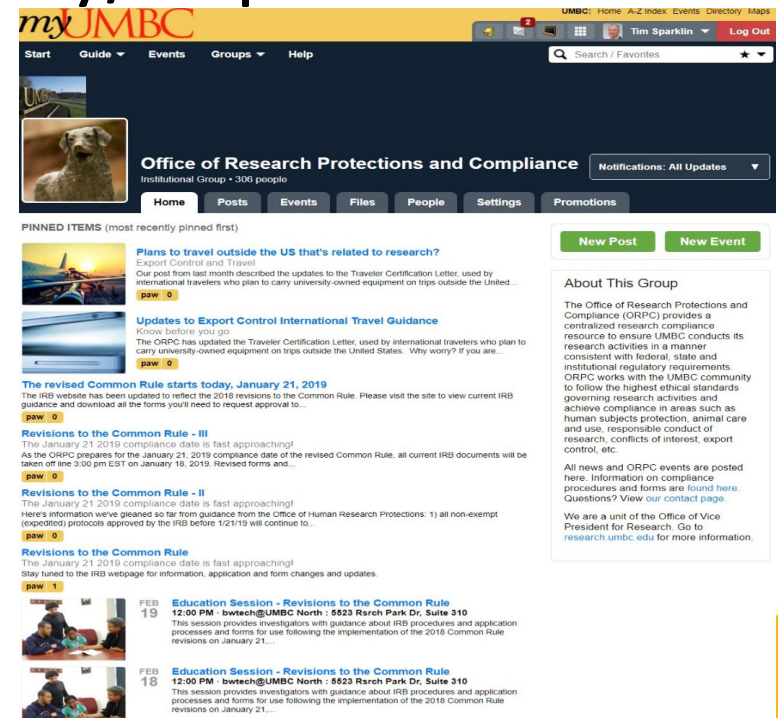
Log into Kuali, then click

Compliance buy in

In addition to training, meet Faculty/Departments on their own turf

- Schedule time at meetings
- Brief Chairs, Department Directors, Deans
- Spread the word via email and campus portals



Legacy data

- **What to input**
 - IACUC – 20
 - IRB – 350
- **How to input**
 - Legacy paper versions different than system forms
- **Why to input**
 - Need to track currently active protocols until termination
- **Who to input**
 - Staffing issues –use current FTEs or hire students
 - Data quality concerns

Before Go Live - System Integration

- Getting system components to talk with another
 - Protocols, Awards, Proposal Development
- Ensure accurate training data uplink
 - CITI training
 - Bio Safety (Web net)
- Not all training data sources have active system links – while waiting need PI or compliance office inputting
