Change.


Don't think of it as always changing; but rather that we are an organization of continuous improvement.

Planning is better than Plans

Support management, yet be willing and able to challenge. "Challenge up" when you honestly disagree with ideas and policies that come from top management. Once final decisions are made, "support down" by standing behind decisions/policies and making them work in the department and the community.
