Examples of Silos

WHO

- Grants
 - Pre-Award
 - Post-Award
 - Agreements
- Compliance/Ethics Reviews
 - O IRB/RFB
 - O IACUC/ACC
 - Resources/procurement/ facilities to support animal studies
 - Biosafety/Biosecurity
 - Export Controls
 - O COI/CoC

WHAT

- Post award <u>needs to know</u> if ethics approvals are in place.
- Animal Facilities <u>need to know</u> what animals to support.
- Biosafety <u>needs to know</u> if animal studies involve agents, toxins, pathogens.
- Upper Admins <u>need to know</u> volume of expenditures and processing for hiring decisions
- PIs need balances (i.e., \$ and animals) and approval statuses
- NSPM-33 and Foreign Influence



Risks of Silos

Shadow systems

- Inconsistent data
- Duplication of efforts
- Old information, forms or templates

Misinformation & Missing Information

- Non-compliance/gaps in compliance
- Key personnel out of the "loop"
- Missed steps (COI disclosures anyone?)

Inefficiencies

- Delay in research activities
 - Frustrated Researchers = Turnover, loss of funding/talent and poor reputation
- Lost communications

 - Hard coded

















Research Administration: Results when implementing a technology solution
