Kim Carter provides leadership and overall direction and management of the Office of Sponsored Projects Administration, including 36 central grants staff, and collaborate and provide leadership to 25 college grant managers. Promote institutional compliance with requirements of external funding agencies. Diagnose and resolve complex issues and problems relating to the administration of grants and contracts. Serve as key resource for understanding all matters related to administering sponsored projects.

Kim has worked previously for over 12 years for the Ohio State University as the Associate Director, Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP). She was responsible for creating, maintaining, implementing and communicating policies and procedures related to research administration and compliance in support of the research endeavors of university community (e.g., subrecipient monitoring, cost sharing, allowable costs, and project post-award monitoring).
