Dr. Goldschmidts received his undergraduate degree from the University of Maryland and Ph.D. in Microbiology from Georgetown University. His postdoctoral research experience at the National Cancer Institute focused on molecular and cellular approaches to develop and evaluate novel therapeutic strategies to treat pediatric and HIV associated lymphomas.

Dr. Goldschmidts was an adjunct faculty member of the Department of Microbiology at the Georgetown University School of Medicine.

Dr. Goldschmidts currently serves on the Board of Directors for the Council on Government Relations (COGR) and teaches Fundamental Grants Management for the National Council of University Research Administrators (NCURA).
